

FULL BLUE LINE CLOSURE

SEPT. 22 – OCT. 4

Starting at 10 p.m. on
Monday, Sept. 22 until
Saturday, Oct. 4:

The **entire METRO Blue Line** will be unavailable due to the Track & Signals project. Replacement bus service will operate along the entire Blue Line.

NOTE: Service to all downtown stations on both the Blue and Green Lines will be unavailable. Replacement buses will serve all affected downtown stations.

Rail replacement bus service

Replacement bus service will be available for all Blue Line stations and will follow the train schedule as traffic conditions allow.

Plan ahead!

- Replacement bus timing can vary and trips may take longer. **Please plan extra time for your trip.**
- Replacement bus schedules will be available at metrotransit.org – track replacement buses with NexTrip at metrotransit.org/nextrip

Paying your fare

- Unlike prior closures, customers will be required to pay their fare upon boarding replacement buses.
- Board through front door and pay the farebox with cash or use your Go-To Card or pass on the card reader.

Ride a bike

You can move around the entire closure or simply between stations as needed.

All replacement buses have free bike racks.

Track & Signals Replacement Project Phase 1

Phase 1 of the Track & Signals project will extend the life of the Blue Line and in particular the rail and switches in the Cedar-Riverside area.

Upon completion, you can expect a smoother ride as the train travels over the new track. It will be worth the wait!

- Replacement of worn track along the entire corridor
- Rail switch replacement in Cedar-Riverside area
